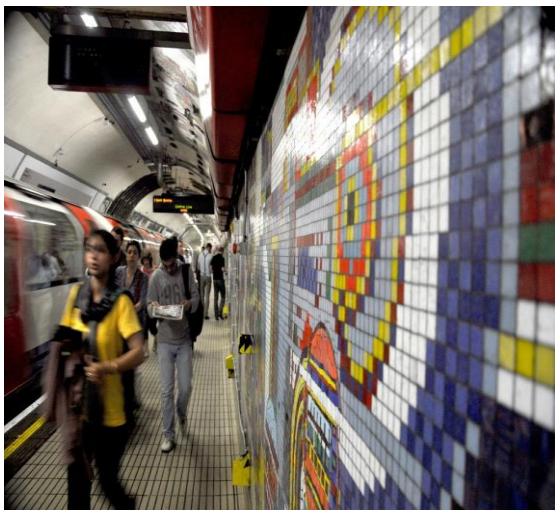

POSTER DAY

What is Poster Day?

The aim of the Poster Day exercise is to get research students to convey their research as simply and graphically as possible to an audience (in the form of a poster). It helps students to think of ways of expressing their ideas and research in a way they haven't before. Judges from each Faculty view the posters and discuss them with students, and the best poster from each Faculty wins a prize. All LSHTM research degree students present at Poster Day some time during their studies at the School.

Why are we expecting interviewees to attend Poster Day?

Poster Day is an opportunity for interviewees to speak to a number of research students at the School (across all 3 faculties) about the research they are currently working on.
