The Doctoral Training Partnership (DTP), which is funded by the Medical Research Council, is a collaboration between two specialist institutions: St George's, University of London (SGUL) and the London School of Hygiene & Tropical Medicine (LSHTM).

The aim of the DTP is to provide integrated skills training to develop a cohort of biomedical and public health scientists with world-class expertise in areas of strategic importance to UK and global medical research.

Our training programme is across three main themes in which we have been at the forefront of innovative research and methodological development: Global Infectious Disease; Quantitative Skills for Large Data Sets; and, Evaluation of Complex Interventions.

MRC LID is overseen by the board of management which comprises academics from both institutions.

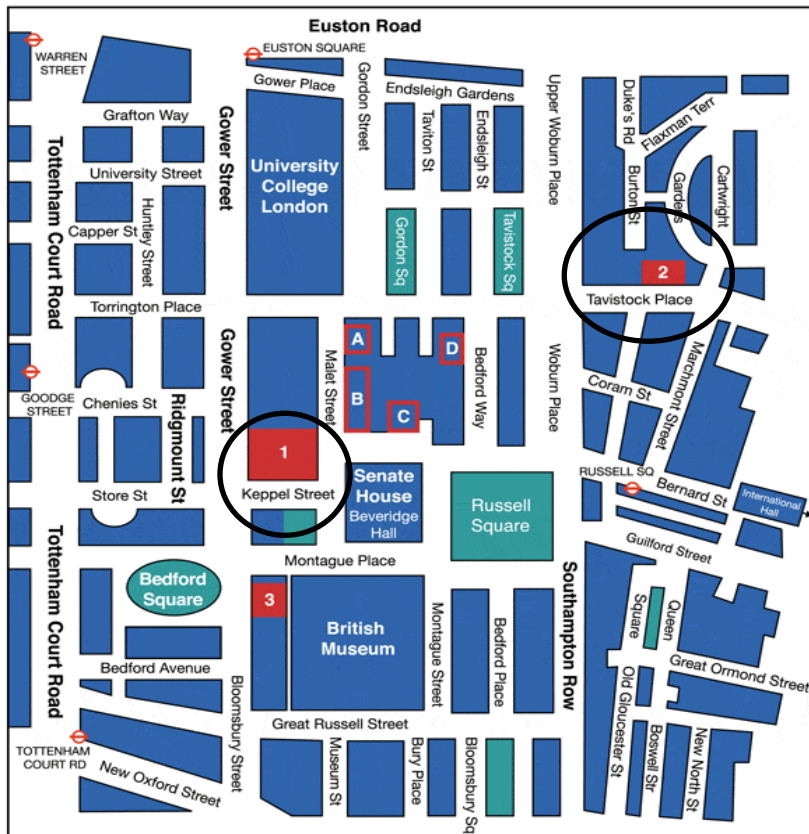
